The applicant also understands that the Town of Provincetown and Provincetown Public Pier Corporation shall not be held responsible for any damages to or loss of any private property or personal injury due to the use of MacMillan Pier or the skiff-dinghy dock. In severe weather conditions, owners may be ordered to move their vessels away from the dock.

Due to the damage sustained to the docks, steel straps have been installed on the floats and all boaters are strongly urged to wear shoes while on the floats.
